**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ORDERING PREPARATION OF THE ANNUAL ENGINEER'S
REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND
COSTS FOR THE MARINA BAY LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE
DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 83-09 dated July 28, 2009, the City Council of the City of Richmond established assessment rates for the Marina Bay Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District and authorized annual increases thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond now wishes to determine whether the rates of assessment for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 should be amended.
