

RESOLUTION NO. 23-20

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ACKNOWLEDGING THAT CONTRA COSTA COUNTY ISSUED HOUSING
REVENUE BONDS TO FINANCE THE REHABILITATION OF THE HACIENDA
APARTMENTS LOCATED IN RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, Hacienda Apartments has requested that the County of Contra Costa (the “County”) consider the issuance of tax-exempt revenue bonds (the “Bonds”) under the provisions of Chapter 7 of Part 5 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code (the “Act”) to finance costs of the acquisition and rehabilitation of Hacienda Apartments, a 150-unit multifamily rental housing facility (the “Project”), located at 1300 Roosevelt Avenue in the City of Richmond (the “City”); and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2020, Contra Costa County adopted Resolution No. 2020/36 issuing multifamily housing revenue bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000,000 to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of Hacienda Apartments, a 150-unit multifamily residential rental housing development located at 1300 Roosevelt Avenue (APN 534-370-028); and

WHEREAS, the County has requested that the City acknowledge that the County will be issuing the Bonds to assist in the financing of the Project, and the County seeks confirmation that the City supports the proposed financing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to acknowledge the County’s role in issuing the Bonds and to confirm that the City supports the financing of the acquisition and rehabilitation of the Project with the proceeds of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, by the agenda report accompanying this Resolution (the “Agenda Report”) the City has been provided with additional information upon which the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution are based.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby accepts that the above recitals are accurate and have served together with the Agenda Report as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby acknowledge the County’s efforts in facilitating the financing of the Project through the issuance of the Bonds pursuant to the Act, and the City Council hereby expresses its support for the financing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City shall have no liability or responsibility whatsoever for the issuance, administration or repayment of the Bonds, and the adoption of this Resolution shall not obligate the City or any department thereof to take any action in connection with any planning approval, permit or other action necessary for the acquisition, rehabilitation or operation of the Project.
