**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING A TRANSFER OF \$1,500,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND CASH
RESERVES TO THE EMERGENCY RECOVERY FUND IN ORDER TO FUND
EXPENDITURES RELATED TO COVID-19**

WHEREAS, the Emergency Recovery Fund (1304) was established to account for revenue and expenditures related to emergency occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the fund was activated in response to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, \$1,500,000 will be transferred from the General Fund cash reserves to fund expenditures related to the COVID-19 response; and

WHEREAS, \$1,500,000 will be appropriated in the Emergency Recovery Fund; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the COVID-19 response, any unspent monies will revert back to the General Fund cash reserves.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby adopts the resolution approving a transfer of \$1,500,000 from the General Fund cash reserves to the Emergency Recovery Fund in order to fund expenditures related to the COVID-19 response.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the budget will be appropriated in the Emergency Recovery Fund.
