

RESOLUTION NO. 43-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
FOR A CONTRACT TO REHABILITATE THIRTY-FOUR (34) MANHOLES IN THE
SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM FOR \$294,130**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond entered into a settlement agreement with San Francisco Baykeeper in 2018 due to the fact that the City experiences significant sanitary sewer overflows during wet rainy weather due to the condition of the City's sanitary sewer collection system; and

WHEREAS, manhole rehabilitation reduces inflow and infiltration of rainwater and groundwater into the collection system; and

WHEREAS, these manholes have been identified through visual inspection; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond and Veolia collectively compiled a list of these manholes; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2019, a request for proposals was posted via "invitation only" to BidsOnLine to the five (5) pre-approved contractors that the City Council had approved with Resolution 52-19; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, two (2) bids were received, and one was retracted by the bidder, leaving W.R. Forde as the single responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, Mary Phelps – Project Manager I, Ofelia Alvarez – Senior Buyer, Sabrina Lundy – Assistant City Clerk, and John Gudjohnson - Veolia Project Manager, reviewed the bids and determined that WR Forde provided a responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the FY 19/20 Manhole Rehabilitation Project will not exceed **\$294,130** [Project cost of \$232,790, plus 10.0% mark-up of \$23,279, plus 15% contingency of \$34,919, plus 9.0% mark-up of \$3,142 on change orders)]; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department will issue a project Task Authorization to Veolia and Veolia Water West Operating Services, Inc. will manage the subcontract with W.R. Forde & Associates.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the Water Resource Recovery Department to enter into a Contract with Veolia for the FY 19/20 Pipeline Replacement/Rehabilitation Project in an amount not to exceed **\$294,130** [Project cost of \$232,790, plus 10.0% mark-up of \$23,279, plus 15% contingency of \$34,919, plus \$3,142 for mark-up on change orders)].

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby appropriates the amount of \$294,130 from the Wastewater Impact Fee Fund 2120 balance to Wastewater Enterprise Funds – Org/Obj 40322931-400708-22235.
