

**RESOLUTION NO. 53-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) FOUR-WAY STOP AT VIRGINIA  
AVE & SOUTH 24<sup>TH</sup> ST, TWO (2) TWO-WAY STOPS AT 3<sup>RD</sup> ST & CHANSLOR AVE  
AND 9<sup>TH</sup> ST & LINCOLN AVE**

**WHEREAS**, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 & 14.28.020 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersections of Virginia Ave. & South 24<sup>th</sup> St. is a four-way stop and all vehicles must stop prior to entering the intersection.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 14.28.010 & 14.28.020 of the Richmond Traffic Code, the City Council declares that the intersection of 3<sup>rd</sup> St. & Chanslor Ave. and 9<sup>th</sup> St. & Lincoln Ave. is a two-way stop and vehicles must stop at stop signs before entering the intersection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersections of Virginia Ave. & South 24<sup>th</sup> St., 3<sup>rd</sup> St. & Chanslor Ave., and 9<sup>th</sup> St. & Lincoln Ave as indicated above.
