

RESOLUTION NO. 72-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
PROCLAIMING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO THE
IMMINENT FAILURE OF THE NORTH RICHMOND PUMP STATION**

WHEREAS, Richmond Municipal Code Section 2.20.060 empowers the City Council to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said city is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has been requested by the Director of Emergency Services of said city to proclaim the existence of a local emergency therein; and

WHEREAS, said City Council does hereby find:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within said city, caused by the imminent failure of the North Richmond Pump Station located on West Gertrude Avenue in North Richmond; and

That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local emergency now exists throughout said city; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this city shall be those prescribed by state law, by ordinances, and resolutions of this city, and by the City of Richmond SEMS/NIMS (Standardized Emergency Management System/National Incident Management System) Emergency Operations Plan, as approved by the City Council on December 17, 2019; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the City Manager is authorized to execute the construction contract with Petersen Power Systems, Inc. to perform emergency repair work to replace the four existing pumps with new pumps at the North Richmond Pump Station.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the City Manager is authorized to amend the construction contract with Petersen Power Systems, Inc. as necessary to complete the emergency repair work to replace the four existing pumps with new pumps at the North Richmond Pump Station.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that said local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council of the City of Richmond, State of California.
