**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE CITY FROM
THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS – BUREAU OF
JUSTICE ASSISTANCE FOR THE CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL
FUNDING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond shall be awarded \$221,800 for expenses (products and service) as it relates to the coronavirus pandemic beginning January 20, 2020, through January 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond desires to accept the funds allocated by the Department of Justice, Officer of the Justice Programs – Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$221,800.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond

- The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$221,800 from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs – Bureau of Justice Assistance.
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated toward program expenditures, under Fund 1006; Org 10691021; Objects 400201, 400384; Project 24120.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund revenue account under Fund 1006, Org 10691021; Objects 334351, Project 24120 for the deposit of the funds, which have been allocated to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director, or designee, of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by state law.
