

RESOLUTION NO. 95-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF
TRAFFIC SAFETY TO FUND AN UPGRADE TO OUR EXISTING CRASH
REPORTING SYSTEM, AND TO PURCHASE AND IMPLEMENT A COMPLETE
ELECTRONIC CITATION SOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the State government has made funds available through the State of California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for the Richmond Police Department to for the purchase of software upgrade as well as the purchase and implementation of electronic traffic citations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond is identified as a grantee and entitled to a maximum of \$73,734.00, with the primary goal of purchasing a software upgrade and new electronic citation equipment; and

WHEREAS, the State of California requires the City Council hold a public meeting to consider the Police Chief's request for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Chief has submitted to the City Council a request that funds, which the City will receive under the allocations, be used to purchase new electronic citation equipment and updated crash reporting software; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that:

1. The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$73,734.00 from the State of California Office of traffic Safety (OTS)
2. The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards upgrading the Crossroads electronic crash reporting software and purchasing and implementing the complete electronic citation solution
3. The grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
4. The City agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by OTS.
5. The Police Department Accountant for the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State Law.


