

**RESOLUTION NO. 116-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF  
FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE CITY FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND  
SECURITY/FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM – COVID-  
19 SUPPLEMENTAL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond Fire Department applied for grant funding from the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS/FEMA) under the FY2020 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program – COVID-19 Supplemental (AFG-S) to provide funds for the purchase of personal protective equipment (PPE) and related supplies, including reimbursements, to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus in the City of Richmond; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant application was approved for a program cost of \$46,966.60, divided between a FEMA award of 90% (\$42,696.91) and a City of Richmond share of 10% (\$4,269.69); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond Fire Department desires to accept and appropriate the funds allocated by the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program – COVID -19 Supplemental (AFG-S) in the amount of \$42,696.91 for the purchase of PPE; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond Fire Department, with prior approval from the Department of Homeland Security/FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program – COVID-19 Supplemental (AFG-S), may make changes in the funding levels between the items outlined in the budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that:

- The City of Richmond shall accept the reimbursement funds of \$42,696.91 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS/FEMA)
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards the expenses above, in accounts to be established by the Finance Department.
- The City Manager, or designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund account string for the deposit of the funds, which will be reimbursed to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
- The City Manager, or designee, shall negotiate and execute all agreements necessary for the implementation of this resolution.


