

RESOLUTION NO. 137-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE PROGRAM NARRATIVE AND BUDGET
AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 FOR THE 2020-2023 CALIFORNIA VIOLENCE
INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION GRANT AWARDED BY THE BOARD OF
STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) desires to participate in the California Violence Intervention and Prevention (CalVIP) Grant funded through the California State General Fund and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as BSCC) on September 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) will provide violence intervention, prevention and suppression activities services through a (3) three-year grant issued BSCC. The grant will serve 245 youth in Richmond and West Contra Costa County through a local collaborative with RYSE Center, Richmond Police Activities League (RPAL), National Council on Crime and Delinquency and the Literacy for Every Adult Program (LEAP) in an effort to reduce violence through evidence-based programs and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager be authorized on behalf of the Council of the City of Richmond to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves the expenditure plan associated with the 2020-2023 CalVIP Grant Award, a (3) three year grant to include the right to negotiate, enter into contracts for (3) three years with RYSE Center (\$375,000), Richmond Police Activities League (RPAL) (\$375,000), National Council on Crime and Delinquency (NCCD) (\$105,000), Literacy for Every Adult Program (LEAP) (\$30,000), Financial Audit Services (\$25,000) and authorizes the ONS to execute all budgetary and program amendments approved by BSCC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) agrees to ensure all matching funds required for the above grant are provided and abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.


