**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING AS-NEEDED FACILITIES DECONTAMINATION SERVICES
CONTRACTOR REPLACEMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000
OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD, FEBRUARY 1, 2021, THROUGH JANUARY 31,
2024, WITH A TWO YEARS EXTENSION**

WHEREAS, On June 2, 2020, Council Approved the selection of three Decontamination Services Contractors: Patriot Environmental Services, NRC Environmental Services Inc. and American Integrated Services, Inc. from a pool of nine candidates; and

WHEREAS, NRC Environmental Services declined to accept the City contract terms:
and

WHEREAS, due the high demand of these decontamination services at several City facilities, it is necessary to replace it with the fourth ranking Contractor American/ATI.; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department will manage the contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond, California, hereby authorizes the Public Works Department to enter into Service Contracts for As-Needed Facilities Decontamination Services, with American/ATI firm for an amount not to exceed \$300,000 per the three year period February 1, 2021 through January 31, 2024, with a two year extension option.
