**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
AUTHORIZING STAFF TO SUBMIT A \$10,608.00 LOCAL MATCH TO THE
METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR THE
PAVEMENT – TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ROUND 22 GRANT**

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is the regional transportation planning agency responsible for disbursing transportation dollars to cities and counties in the nine-county San Francisco Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, MTC developed, owns, maintains, and updates the StreetSaver® pavement asset management system platform that local Bay Area cities and counties utilize for their individual pavement management systems; and

WHEREAS, MTC requires local agencies to update their StreetSaver® pavement management program on a regular basis including performing pavement distress surveys on Arterial Streets and Collector Streets at least every two years and on Residential Streets at least every five years and deems this pavement distress survey requirement a “performance measure” in order for the local agencies to remain eligible for certain types of formulaic federal pavement rehabilitation dollars disbursed regionally by MTC; and

WHEREAS, MTC disburses grant funding on an annual basis via the Pavement - Technical Assistance Program (P-TAP) for local cities and counties to update their individual StreetSaver® pavement management systems in order for MTC to maintain up-to-date regional pavement data for long term planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City recently submitted a grant application for P-TAP Round 22 and was informed by MTC that the City’s P-TAP Round 22 grant application will be recommended for funding at the upcoming January 13, 2021, MTC Administration Committee Meeting; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the number of miles of pavement in the City’s pavement network that are currently due for update, City staff recently submitted a P-TAP grant application for \$53,040.00 and must submit the required 20% local match, or \$10,608.00, for final approval of the P-TAP grant, and this amount is available in the CIP budget; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the 20% local match, or \$10,608.00, MTC will enter into an Agreement directly with a Certified Consultant to perform the StreetSaver® pavement management program update; and

WHEREAS, City staff will monitor the progress of the Certified Consultant to ensure compliance with MTC project milestone guidelines, and MTC will pay the Certified Consultant only after the City has provided MTC with concurrence for milestones completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED upon approval of the funding by MTC and upon receipt of an invoice from MTC, Council authorizes payment of the 20% local match, or \$10,608, to MTC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision herein is based. These documents may be found at the office of the City Clerk at the Richmond City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, CA 94804.


