**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND  
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A  
PROPOSITION 64 PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT AND EXECUTE ANY  
SUBSEQUENT GRANT AGREEMENTS**

**WHEREAS** the City of Richmond, California (“Applicant”) desires to participate in the Title II Grant Program funded through the US Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as BSCC); and

**WHEREAS**, a Grant Agreement needs to be executed with the BSCC before such funds can be claimed through the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Applicant wishes to delegate authorization to execute these agreements and any amendments thereto to the City Manager; and.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is authorized on behalf of the City Council of the City of Richmond to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereto.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Richmond:

1. Authorizes the City Manager to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute all Grant Agreements and any amendments thereto with the BSCC; and
3. Authorizes the City Manager to execute any contract and/or agreement with the specified grant partners; and,
4. Authorizes acceptance and appropriation of all grant funds for the multi-year term of the grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
