

RESOLUTION NO. 13-21

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE DRAFT FERRY TO BRIDGE TO GREENWAY
COMPLETE STREETS PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond applied for and received a Caltrans Community Based Transportation Planning Grant to develop the Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Complete Streets Plan (the “F2B2G Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the F2B2G Plan identifies walking and biking improvements to connect the Richmond Ferry Terminal, Richmond-San Rafael (RSR) Bridge Multi-Use Trail, Richmond Greenway and points of interest between these destinations, overcoming existing connectivity barriers between these destinations to ensure that the benefits of safe transportation access for employment, education and recreation are shared citywide; and

WHEREAS, the F2B2G Plan implements General Plan 2030 *Goal CR1: An Expanded Multimodal Circulation System*, with a focus on safer and more attractive conditions for all modes; “*Goal CR2: Walkable Neighborhoods and Complete Streets*” to make walking and biking more attractive and enhance connectivity between neighborhoods, schools, and work places; *Goal CR3: A Safe and Well-Maintained Circulation System*, which emphasizes safety and maintenance improvements; and *Goal CR5: Sustainable and Green Practices*, which emphasizes sustainable solutions including stormwater treatment through pedestrian amenities; and

WHEREAS, the F2B2G Plan was developed with significant community input and engagement from area residents, businesses, stakeholder groups, and public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the F2B2G Plan is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15262, consisting of projects involving only feasibility or planning studies needed for possible future action for which an agency, board, or commission has not approved, adopted, or funded and the F2B2G Plan does not have a legally binding effect on later activities; and

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2021, the Council considered adoption of the draft F2B2G Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby find that the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report dated February 16, 2021 as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.
