

RESOLUTION NO. 24-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT THREE NEW GRANT AWARDS; ONE LOCAL GRANT FROM MARIN CLEAN ENERGY, ONE STATE GRANT OF SB1 FUNDING PASSED THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION TRADES WORKFORCE INITIATIVE, AND ONE STATE GRANT PASSED THROUGH ALAMEDA COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION, AND ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$499,500 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$499,500 IN THE 2020-2021 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded \$87,500 from Marin Clean Energy, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$87,500 will be used to provide Richmond residents with pre-apprenticeship construction skills training at the RichmondBUILD Academy, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$364,500 in California SB1 funding passed through the Construction Trades Workforce Initiative , and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$364,500 will be used to provide Richmond residents with pre-apprenticeship construction skills training at the RichmondBUILD Academy, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded \$47,500 from the State of California K12 Strong Workforce Funding funding, passed through the Alameda County Office of Education, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$47,500 and is aimed at providing meaningful work experience opportunities to youth, focusing on youth with disabilities, and

WHEREAS, these three new grants will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2020-2021 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$499,500 to revenue and to add \$499,500 to expenditures.
