ORDERING PREPARATION OF AN ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR
2021-2022 REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND COSTS FOR THE HILLTOP
LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 91-98 dated June 23, 1998, the City Council of the City of Richmond established for the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance Assessment District rates assessment and authorized annual increases thereof; and
