**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ORDERING PREPARATION OF THE ANNUAL ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2021-2022 REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND COSTS FOR THE MARINA
BAY LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 83-09 dated July 28, 2009, the City Council of the City of Richmond established assessment rates for the Marina Bay Landscape and Lighting Maintenance District and authorized annual increases thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond now wishes to determine whether the rates of assessment for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 should be amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND

(1) The Engineer shall prepare a report that describes any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements.


