

**RESOLUTION NO. 34-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY AND ADJUST  
APPROPRIATIONS BY \$5,000 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$5,000 IN THE  
2020-2021 LIBRARY BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, the Library was awarded \$5,000 from the California State Library, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$5,000 will be used to purchase a collection of children’s picture books featuring diverse characters, and

**WHEREAS**, this grant funding will expand Richmond Public Library’s collection of picture books representing a diverse community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2020-2021 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$5,000 to revenue and to add \$5,000 to expenditures.
