A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A NEW GRANT AWARD FROM BNSF RAILWAY FOUNDATION, AND ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$5,000.00 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$5,000.00 IN THE 2020-2021 COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT BUDGET


