**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
TO ACCEPT TWO NEW GRANT AWARDS; TWO FEDERAL GRANTS PASSED  
THROUGH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT  
DEPARTMENT AND TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$278,146.16 AND TO  
ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$278,146.16 IN THE 2020-2021 EMPLOYMENT AND  
TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded \$274,300 from the California Employment Development Department English Language Learners Program funding, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$274,300 will be used to provide Richmond residents who are English Language Learners with occupational skills training and on-the-job training opportunities, and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the 2020-2021 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$3,846.16 from the WIOA Governor's Discretionary funding for meeting the standards established for designation as a WIOA High Performing Board, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$3,846.16 will be used to supplement Employment and Training programs, and

**WHEREAS**, these two new grants will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2020-2021 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$278,146.16 to revenue and to add \$278,146.16 to expenditures.


