**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ALLOW THE TRANSPORTATION
DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLEAN MOBILITY OPTIONS
VOUCHER PILOT PROGRAM TO DEVELOP AND OPERATE A LOCAL
ELECTRIC ON DEMAND SHUTTLE SERVICE**

WHEREAS, The City of Richmond, as Lead Applicant, submitted a Mobility Project Voucher Application on October 20, 2020, for the Clean Mobility Options Voucher Pilot Program (CMO). The application submitted was for the Richmond On-Demand, local electric shuttle service, for the Richmond community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond is eligible to receive funding through CMO, a statewide initiative funded by California Climate Investments, and administered by California Air Resource Board's Program Administrator team to provide funding for zero-emission shared mobility options to under-resourced communities in California; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond will comply with the requirements of the CMO program; will accept the CMO voucher funds; and will allocate the amount of \$1,000,000, including any Community Resource Contributions, committed to the project in the CMO application and as amended by the Program Administrator and awardee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond is committed to implementing clean transportation strategies and increasing transportation equity in Richmond's SB 535 designated Disadvantaged Communities (DAC), and endeavors to expand and sustain this shuttle service program beyond the pilot period to serve the community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager shall be authorized to allow the Transportation Department to execute the approval of CMO voucher funds, reiterate CMO program commitment, and compliance with CMO program requirements to the CMO Program Administrator Team.
