

**RESOLUTION NO. 82-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT  
TO W. R. FORDE ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR THE CUTTING BOULEVARD AND  
HARBOUR WAY SOUTH BIKEWAYS PROJECT**

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**WHEREAS**, the Circulation Element of the Richmond General Plan 2030 provides goals, policies and actions intended to ensure efficient mobility and access for all City residents, workers and visitors through a safe, interconnected, multimodal transportation system; and

**WHEREAS**, Action CR2.A of the General Plan Circulation Element calls for the development of access and mobility criteria for capital improvement projects to ensure safe connections to schools, transit hubs, and employment centers, to make non-vehicular modes of getting to and from work, school, and transit safer and more appealing; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 16, 2021, the Richmond City Council adopted a resolution adopting the Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Plan Complete Streets Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Plan identifies walking and bicycling improvements to connect the Richmond Ferry Terminal, the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge Multi-Use Trail, and the Richmond Greenway as well as points of interest in between these destinations, overcoming existing connectivity barriers between these destinations to ensure that the benefits of safe transportation access for employment, education, and recreation are shared citywide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cutting Boulevard and Harbour Way South Bikeways project was designed to close a large gap in bicycle facilities between the Richmond Ferry Terminal and the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised the Cutting Boulevard and Harbour Way South Bikeways construction contract in conformance to applicable California Public Contracting Code, and on June 17, 2021, following the public bid process for construction, W. R. Forde Associates, Inc., demonstrated itself to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, staff desires to award a construction contract to W. R. Forde Associates, Inc., for the Project in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,783,969.00, including construction contingencies; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funds and SB 1 local funds allocated for this project are sufficient to fund the cost of construction; and

**WHEREAS**, by the agenda report (“Agenda Report”) accompanying this resolution the City Council has been provided with additional information upon which the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution are based.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby authorizes the award of a construction contract to W. R. Forde Associates, Inc., for the construction of the Cutting Boulevard and Harbour Way South Bikeways Project in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,783,969.00 (including construction contingencies).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to execute and make amendments to the construction contract as needed to facilitate the completion of the Project.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision herein is based. These documents may be found at the office of the City Clerk at the Richmond City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California 94804.


