

RESOLUTION NO. 90-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, FOR APPROPRIATING BUDGET FOR FY 2021-22 AND APPROVING THE SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE OF A NASSCO® COMPLIANT PUSH CAMERA WITH A CONNECTOR CABLE OF 500 FT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISIONING OF THE SANITARY COLLECTION SYSTEM OF THE RICHMOND MUNICIPAL SEWER DISTRICT AND THE STORM SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF RICHMOND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$44,663.42

WHEREAS, the Veolia North America (Veolia) is the City of Richmond's contractor for operating and maintaining the Sanitary and Storm Sewer Collection systems; and

WHEREAS, the contract between Veolia and the City of Richmond (City) requires Veolia to perform routine inspections and assess the internal condition of the collections system on a ten-year cycle; and

WHEREAS, this work requires televising equipment that is compliant per National Association of Sewer Service Companies (NASSCO®) standards; and

WHEREAS, in order to televise the sewer pipes that have a diameter of four (4) inches to six (6) inches in diameter and that are longer than 300 feet in length between access points (manholes and/or clean-outs), a special cable is required to connect to the televising camera; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined the only manufacturer of such a camera with the required cable is the Cues® Mini Portable TV System MPLUS XL+; and

WHEREAS, WECO Industries is the only vendor that sells this NASSCO® compliant camera in Northern California; and

WHEREAS, this camera system is necessary for Veolia to fulfill the terms of the contract with the City which requires the collection system to be condition assessed via CCTV every ten years; and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department will issue a Task Authorization approving sole source purchase of the Cues® Mini Portable TV System MPLUS XL+ in the amount of \$44,663.42 [equipment cost of \$40,603.11 plus 10% mark-up of \$4,060.31]; and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department will appropriate funds in the amount of \$44,663.42 from the Wastewater Fund Balance; and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department FY 2021-22 expenses will be amended in the amount of \$44,663.42.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this City Council hereby so finds and determines:

Section 2. The Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department shall issue a Sole Source Task Authorization for the purchase of Cues® Mini Portable TV System MPLUS XL+ in the amount of \$44,663.42.

Section 3. The Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department will appropriate and amend funds from the Wastewater Fund Balance in the amount of \$44,663.42.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
