

RESOLUTION NO. 96-21

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
APPROPRIATING BUDGET FROM THE 2019A WASTEWATER BOND PROCEEDS
FOR THE BAAQMD PERMITTING FOR THE GRIT REMOVAL, AERATION
PROCESS UPGRADE AND BIOFILTER REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO BE
AWARDED TO YORKE ENGINEERING AND MANAGED BY VEOLIA WATER FOR
\$19,139**

WHEREAS, in 2019, Veolia engaged Yorke Engineering, LLC. to provide assistance to Veolia and the City of Richmond for BAAQMD Permitting for the Grit Removal, Aeration Process Upgrade and Biofilter Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, currently, Veolia is planning to replace the flare at the City of Richmond Water Pollution Control Plant (Richmond WWTP) as related to the Cogen Project; and

WHEREAS, several flare designs have been given to the City of Richmond, but a model has not been chosen yet; and

WHEREAS, the current flare is permitted as a single unit and has three burners; and

WHEREAS, as the current flare is permitted with the BAAQMD; and

WHEREAS, the new flare will also require permitting and must meet current BAAQMD standards for Best Available Control Technology (BACT); and

WHEREAS, Veolia needs to request a 2-year extension from the BAAQMD to the Authority to Construct (ATC) for the CHP engine; and

WHEREAS, Veolia solicited three quotes from environmental firms to accomplish this work: Yorke Engineering, Environmental Science Associates (ESA) and Mizutani Environmental; and

WHEREAS, two (2) quotes were received: Yorke Engineering (\$16,428) and Mizutani Environmental (\$48,400); and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the quotes and determined that Yorke Engineering's quote was the lowest responsive quote; and

WHEREAS, the BAAQMD Permitting for the Grit Removal, Aeration Process Upgrade and Biofilter Replacement Project will not exceed **\$19,139** (project price of **\$16,428** plus 16.5% mark-up of **\$2,711**); and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department will issue a project Task Authorization to Veolia and Veolia Water West Operating Services, Inc. will manage the subcontract with Yorke Engineering.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this City Council hereby so finds and determines:

Section 2. The Water Resource Recovery Division of the Public Works Department shall appropriate funds from the 2019A Wastewater Bond proceeds in the amount of **\$19,139** for Fiscal Year 2021-22 budget for the BAAQMD Permitting for the Grit Removal, Aeration Process Upgrade and Biofilter Replacement Project.

Section 3. The Contract shall be managed by Veolia Water and a subcontract issued to Yorke Engineering for the BAAQMD Permitting for the Grit Removal, Aeration Process Upgrade and Biofilter Replacement Project.

Section 4. The total cost of the BAAQMD Permitting for the Grit Removal, Aeration Process Upgrade and Biofilter Replacement Project will not exceed **\$19,139** (project price of **\$16,428** plus 16.5% mark-up of **\$2,711**)

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
