**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA ADJUSTING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2006-2007
WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT (WIA) AND GRANT PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2006-2007 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training received additional performance-based funding and competitive funding for (WIA) programs from the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Employment and Training Department also received additional WIA formula funds passed through Alameda County, and CDBG funds and Redevelopment Project funds passed through the Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding represents an approximate 4.1% increase in funds to the Employment and Training Department; and

WHEREAS, the receipt of these additional funds requires adjustments to appropriations to Special Projects funds for fiscal year 2006-2007 as follows:
