**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE  
REVISED CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF PORT AUTHORITIES AGREEMENT  
WITH THE FEDERAL MARITIME COMMISSION**

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**WHEREAS**, the Port of Richmond is a member of the California Association of Port Authorities (CAPA); and

**WHEREAS**, CAPA and the Federal Maritime Commission (FMC) entered into an Agreement in 1940 to provide for the establishment and maintenance of just and reasonable terminal rates, rules, and regulations at members' ports; and

**WHEREAS**, the CAPA agreement with the FMC has not been significantly updated to reflect current port operations throughout the State of California since 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Richmond is seeking approval to execute the revised CAPA agreement with the FMC.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City Council hereby approves the revised CAPA agreement with the FMC.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the revised CAPA agreement with the FMC.
