

RESOLUTION NO. 110-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT THREE NEW GRANT AWARDS; ONE FEDERAL GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, ONE GRANT FROM THE Y & H SODA FOUNDATION, AND ONE GRANT FROM THE RICHMOND FUND FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH AND TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$1,043,164 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$1,043,164 IN THE 2021-2022 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DIVISION BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded \$893,164 from the U.S. Department of Labor , in WIA National Emergency Grants (NEG), WIOA Dislocated Worker Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$893,164 will be used to provide dislocated Richmond residents with occupational skills training and on-the-job training opportunities; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded \$25,000 from the Y & H Soda Foundation to directly support the RichmondBUILD Construction Skills Academy for pre-apprenticeship job training; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$25,000 will be used to supplement Employment and Training/RichmondBUILD Construction Skills Academy pre-apprenticeship job training programs; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, Employment and Training was awarded a \$125,000 from the Richmond Fund for Children and Youth as education support and Employment Training support for the RichmondBUILD Construction Skills Academy; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$125,000 will be used to supplement Employment and Training/RichmondBUILD Construction Skills Academy pre-apprenticeship job training programs; and

WHEREAS, these three new grants will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$1,043,164 to revenue and to add \$1,043,164 to expenditures.
