

RESOLUTION NO. 113-21

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, RENAMING SOUTH STREET TO ETHEL DOTSON SOUTH**

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing to rename South Street to Ethel Dotson South was duly mailed to property owners and residents on South Street and published in the West County Times on September 4, 2021, as required by City of Richmond policy, as appears from the affidavit of publishing now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on September 14, 2021, the City Council (the "Council") adopted a Resolution stating its intention ("Resolution of Intention") to rename South Street to Ethel Dotson South and setting a public hearing for all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed street name change for September 28, 2021, at 6:30 P.M. or as soon thereafter as practicable in the Richmond City Council Chambers; and

WHEREAS, not less than ten (10) days have elapsed since the date of passage of said Resolution of Intention; and

WHEREAS, the name change is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, the Council has authority under Government Code Section 34091.1 to adopt a resolution to rename an existing public street; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing on the proposed street name change was duly held at such appointed date, time and place and the Council considered all comments made orally and in writing regarding the proposed name.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond does hereby resolve as follows:

- Section 1. Pursuant to the authority vested in the City Council by Government Code Section 34091.1, the City Council hereby changes the name of South Street to Ethel Dotson South; and
- Section 2. That the City Clerk and the Public Works Department are hereby directed to take whatever steps are required by law to notify the public of said name change, including providing any required notices, including to the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors pursuant to Government Code Section 34092, and proceed to make physical improvements to the street that reflect the intent of this resolution.
