

**RESOLUTION NO. 118-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A MAINTENANCE  
AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF HARBOUR WAY SOUTH AND HOFFMAN BOULEVARD**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is in the process of installing signage and striping in Caltrans' right-of-way at the intersection of Harbour Way South and Hoffman Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to complete this installation, Caltrans requires the City to enter into a maintenance agreement that obligates the City to maintain the installed signage and striping; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Bicycle Master Plan identifies a proposed bikeway network consisting of routes that are designed to be the primary system for bicyclists traveling in and through Richmond; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bicycle Master Plan's focus areas include key bicycle corridors, improving safety and access along freeways and through interchanges, and improving access to the Bay Trail and waterfront; and

**WHEREAS**, Harbour Way South and Hoffman Boulevard are portions of the San Francisco Bay Trail and Harbour Way South is a Key Corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant-funded and award-winning Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Complete Streets Plan provides valuable connections for people bicycling and walking to the Richmond Ferry, Richmond-San Rafael Bridge multi-use path, and the Richmond Greenway; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Complete Streets Plan includes conceptual designs that recommend installing a Class IV protected bikeway on Harbour Way South, Hoffman Boulevard, and Cutting Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded grant funding from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and the Active Transportation Program to implement Ferry to Bridge to Greenway designs on Harbour Way South, Hoffman Boulevard, and Cutting Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, construction documents have been prepared for the Cutting Boulevard and Harbour Way South Bikeways project which include the installation of striping and signage improvements in the Caltrans right-of-way at Harbour Way South and Hoffman Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, Caltrans will only issue an Encroachment Permit for the Cutting Boulevard and Harbour Way South Bikeway project if a Maintenance Agreement is created for the City to maintain its improvements in the Caltrans right-of-way at the intersection of Harbour Way South and Hoffman Boulevard;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the Maintenance Agreement.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision herein is based. These documents may be found at the office of the City Clerk at the Richmond City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California 94804.


