

RESOLUTION NO. 133-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE PACIFIC LIBRARY PARTNERSHIP AND ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$10,000 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$10,000 IN THE 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Library was awarded \$10,000 from the Pacific Library Partnership, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$10,000 will be used to purchase lendable early learning and standalone audiobooks for children, and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will expand access to Richmond Public Library's early learning and children's audiobooks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$10,000 to revenue and to add \$10,000 to expenditures.
