

RESOLUTION NO. 140-21

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
AMENDING THE COUNCIL'S RULES OF PROCEDURE AND ORDER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 of Article III of the Charter of the City of Richmond, the Council of the City of Richmond has established rules and procedures pertaining to meetings of the City Council by adopting Resolution 61-13, as amended on April 22, 2014, October 21, 2014, and July 27, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that Section II. Meetings C., Closed Session is modified to read as follows:

A closed session may be held at any regular or special meeting for any purpose authorized by the Brown Act. Council actions shall be governed by the Brown Act. Public comment shall be received in open session prior to a closed session. To ensure strict compliance with the Brown Act, the City Attorney, or the City Attorney's designee, shall be the individual who reports out in public session any reportable action taken during closed session, and any other information from closed session authorized to be disclosed by a majority vote of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council's rules shall otherwise remain as previously adopted and amended as set forth above.
