**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CITY OF
RICHMOND AND PART-TIME & INTERMITTENT EMPLOYEE BARGAINING UNIT
REPRESENTED BY SEIU, LOCAL 1021**

WHEREAS, the Part-Time & Intermittent Employee Bargaining Unit is represented by Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 1021; and

WHEREAS, the City and SEIU, Local 1021 are required under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act to meet and confer in good faith regarding wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the City and SEIU, Local 1021, having met and conferred in good faith reached a total tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement for the Part-Time & Intermittent Employee Bargaining Unit; and

WHEREAS, the successor collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the membership of SEIU, Local 1021 and the City Council is required to adopt the successor collective bargaining agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Richmond adopts the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Richmond and the Part-Time & Intermittent Employee Bargaining Unit represented by SEIU, Local 1021 and directs the City Manager or designee to update the publicly available salary schedule with the adopted wage increases during the term of the collective bargaining agreement.


