

RESOLUTION NO. 155-21

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH SHAW SPORTS
TURF TO PERFORM THE DRAINAGE REPAIRS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$150,000 AND APPROPRIATE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, the City of Richmond (“City”) entered into a contract with Shaw Sports Turf to replace the turf at Martin Luther King, Jr. Field (“Contract”); and

WHEREAS, after the City began working on the Martin Luther King, Jr. Field Turf replacement project, it was determined that the field required more work than was originally budgeted (\$150,000); and

WHEREAS, the City desire to amend the Shaw Contract to provide for additional funds necessary to perform the required work to repair the drainage at the MLK Field Turf; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the requirements of the American Rescue Plan Act ARPA (31 CFR § 35) and is of the opinion that this project would qualify as a permitted use of funds to provide necessary water and sewer infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the proposed contract amendment with Shaw Sports Turf to perform the drainage repairs at Martin Luther King, Jr Field for a time and materials, not to exceed amount of \$135,958 and a 10% contingency of \$14,042 for a total budget of \$150,000 and to appropriate said monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund.
