

RESOLUTION NO. 19-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION(S) FOR ALL
CALRECYCLE GRANTS FOR WHICH THE CITY OF RICHMOND IS ELIGIBLE**

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (state) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for all CalRecycle grants or payment programs for which the applicant is eligible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager, or their designee is hereby authorized as the Signature Authority and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Richmond all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds, implement the approved grant project and close-out the grant(s);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED if awarded the grant it can be accepted and appropriated accordingly into the City's budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for City of Richmond Fiscal Years' 2021-2022 through 2025-2026.
