DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, specifically Engineering, requires plan review and inspections for development projects, including subdivision maps, improvements plans, utility connections, and public right-of-way improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department sometimes needs to rely on consultants to assist in plan review and hold several on-call consultants to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has adopted plan review fees associated with development projects as part of the City Master Fee schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals accurate and with the Agenda Report serve as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Council hereby appropriates revenue and expenditures related to Plan Review and inspection services into the Public Works fiscal year 2021/22 budget.
