

**RESOLUTION NO. 108-20(B)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND  
ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT GRANT PROVIDING FUNDS TO THE CITY  
OF RICHMOND FOR EXPENDITURES INCURRED IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

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**WHEREAS**, the CARES Act provides funding for costs and necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency related to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been actively engaged in complying with the State of California and Contra Costa County Health order by implementing pandemic mitigation steps to reduce the rate of coronavirus (COVID-19) infection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond was awarded an allocation totaling \$1,356,676 under the CARES Act for COVID-19 related expenditures incurred beginning March 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond received its first allocation of \$228,869 for costs incurred beginning March 15, 2020, through June 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, a special project code has been created in the Emergency Recovery Fund (1304) to account for the CARES Act grant revenue received and expenditures incurred; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of the Treasury, Office of the Inspector General (OIG) has identified 18 distinct categories for reporting expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is required to report expenditures incurred as per the guidelines set by OIG; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond has developed the CARES Act funding expenditure plan to cover costs under the eligible expenditure categories; and

**WHEREAS**, the CARES Act funding expenditure plan includes an allocation of funds to support Richmond Rapid Response Fund (R3F) rental and mortgage assistance program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby adopts the resolution to accept and appropriate the CARES Act grant allocation in the amount of \$1,356,676 for expenditures incurred related to the City of Richmond's response to COVID-19.
