RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE BAY AREA LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SYSTEM, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$7,000 AND ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$7,000 IN THE 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Richmond Public Library was awarded \$7,000 from the Bay Area Library and Information System; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$7,000 will be used to support library staff development, public programming, and strategic planning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$7,000 to revenue and to add \$7,000 to expenditures.
