RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$3,550 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$3,550 IN THE 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Richmond Public Library was awarded \$3,550 from the California State Library; and

WHEREAS, the additional grant funding of \$3,550 will be used to purchase materials for NASA@MyLibrary program kits; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will expand Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (“STEM”) programming for children visiting the Richmond Public Library,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$3,550 to revenue and to add \$3,550 to expenditures.
