**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING REGIONAL EARLY IMPACT
PLANNING FUNDS RECEIVED TO SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF CITY'S 6th
CYCLE HOUSING ELEMENT UPDATE**

WHEREAS, a Housing Element is a required element of a General Plan that is required to be updated every eight years to align with the Regional Housing Need Allocation; and

WHEREAS, City of Richmond (City) is in the process of updating its Housing Element for the 6th Cycle (2023-2031); and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) received Regional Early Impact Planning (REAP) grant funds awarded by the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD); and

WHEREAS, in 2021, the City submitted a proposal to ABAG for a REAP suballocation request to support the community engagement portion of the 6th Cycle Housing Element update; and

WHEREAS, ABAG is awarding the City \$45,690 in REAP suballocation funds that now needs to be accepted and appropriated into the FY21/22 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council finds the above recitals accurate and, coupled with the Agenda Report, these documents serve as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Council hereby accepts and authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute a Suballocation Agreement with ABAG, and appropriates the \$45,690 in REAP funds received and expenditures related to development of the City's 6th Cycle Housing Element Update into the Community Development fiscal year 2021/22 budget.
