**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY,
ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$21,700 AND ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$21,700
IN THE 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Richmond Public Library was awarded \$21,700 from the California State Library; and

WHEREAS, the additional grant funding of \$21,700 will be able to provide adult literacy services to Literacy For Every Adult Program (LEAP) English as a Second Language (ESL) participants.

WHEREAS, this grant funding will expand ESL services at the Richmond Public Library's adult literacy service, LEAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$21,700 to revenue and to add \$21,700 to expenditures.
