TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE PACIFIC LIBRARY PARTNERSHIP AND  
ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$7,402 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$7,402  
IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Library was awarded \$7,402 from the Pacific Library Partnership, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$7,402 will be used towards Link+ delivery costs, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2021-2022 Library Fund Budget is adjusted to add \$7,402 to revenue and to add \$7,402 to expenditures.
