

RESOLUTION NO. 74-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$250,000, AND ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$250,000 IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 City operating budget, the California State Library awarded the Richmond Public Library \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will enable the Richmond Public Library to design and procure a new Bookmobile for service to Richmond children and families.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the FY 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$250,000 to revenue and to add \$250,000 to expenditures.
