

RESOLUTION NO. 75-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$3,200 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$3,200 IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, the California State Library provides funding through the Lunch at the Library program to support literacy programs and book distribution at free summer meal sites; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 City of Richmond operating budget, the Richmond Public Library was awarded \$3,200 to support literacy programs and book giveaways at local summer meal sites; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$3,200 to revenue and to add \$3,200 to expenditures.
