

RESOLUTION NO. 107-22

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN RIVERS IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$300,500 FOR THE FLOOD RISK REDUCTION IN RHEEM CREEK
WATERSHED PROJECT**

WHEREAS, in 2019, American Rivers obtained a planning and design grant from the California State Coastal Conservancy for the “Community-Based Ecological Solutions in Rheem Creek Watershed” project; and

WHEREAS, in this project American Rivers collaborated with the City of Richmond (City), The Watershed Project, and Restoration Design Group to conduct community engagement activities, perform a topographic survey and hydraulic analysis, create preliminary design plans and a restoration opportunities analysis report, and submit permits to regulatory agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City collaborated with American Rivers, The Watershed Project, and Restoration Design Group to apply to the California Natural Resources Agency Urban Flood Protection Grant Program for the Flood Risk Reduction in the Rheem Creek Watershed Project; and

WHEREAS, the Flood Risk Reduction in the Rheem Creek Watershed grant application defines the Project Team as the City, The Watershed Project, Restoration Design Group, and American Rivers; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2021, the Richmond City Council passed and adopted Resolution No. 83-21, approving the application for grant funds for the Urban Flood Projection Grant and authorizing the City Manager, or their designee, to execute agreements with project partners to complete the grant-funded project; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2021, the California Natural Resources Agency awarded the City of Richmond \$1,598,844 for the Flood Risk Reduction in the Rheem Creek Watershed Project; and

WHEREAS, staff initiated a Sole Source Request for hiring American Rivers to provide various services outlined in the grant, and to subcontract with The Watershed Project and Restoration Design Group, and the Director of Public Works and the Finance Department approved the Sole Source Request; and

WHEREAS, American Rivers is a national non-profit with a California office and deep local connections and partnerships; and

WHEREAS, the Flood Risk Reduction in the Rheem Creek Watershed Project will rehabilitate a 2,000-foot section of Rheem Creek and reduce flooding in the surrounding neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the award of a Sole Source professional services contract to American Rivers for the Flood Risk Reduction in the Rheem Creek Watershed Project, in an amount not to exceed \$300,500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution take effect immediately upon its passage.
