

RESOLUTION NO. 133-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY, ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$54,300 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$54,300 IN THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR LIBRARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the City of Richmond fiscal year 2022-2023 operating budget, the Richmond Public Library - LEAP was awarded \$54,300 from the California State Library; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will enable the Richmond Public Library - LEAP to assist adults in learning to speak, read and write in English and obtain the knowledge and skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Fiscal Year 2022 - 2023 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$54,300 to revenue and to expenditures.


