

RESOLUTION NO. 136-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, TO RECEIVE \$150,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ASSOCIATION
OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS (ABAG) FOR THE NORTH SHORE (GOODRICK
AVENUE) BAY TRAIL GAP CLOSURE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2012, the City Council of the City of Richmond (the “City Council”) adopted the Richmond General Plan 2030 (the “General Plan”), which establishes the goals, policies and implementing actions for development of the City of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, Policy CR1.6 of the General Plan calls for completion of the San Francisco Bay Trail in Richmond; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond staff, applied to the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to provide for construction funding on behalf of the Point Molate Bay Trail Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2022, the City of Richmond was awarded construction grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 by the ABAG for the purposes of aiding in the construction of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby accept and appropriate, and administer the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) San Francisco Bay Trail grant funds for Project construction, and appoints the City Manager, or his designee, as agent to administer, conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the project.

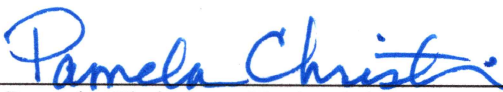
