**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM CONTRA COSTA COUNTY
HEALTH SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S PREHOSPITAL
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County Health Services Emergency Medical Services Division appropriated monies through Measure H pursuant to Agreement #23-551-4 with the City of Richmond Fire Department to support first responder Emergency Medical Services (EMS) through training, certifications, and the purchase of medical equipment and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Health Services Emergency Medical Services Division will allocate funding to the City of Richmond Fire Department from July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$229,462 annually, based on the provisions outlined in Interagency Agreement #23-551-4; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department shall be awarded an amount not to exceed \$688,386 for projected services and expenditures over the term of the contract, commencing July 1, 2022, and running through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department, with written approvals from the EMS Agency Director and Department Fire Chief, shall allow the Contra Costa County Health Services Emergency Medical Services Division to deduct from the annual distributions any costs associated with the EMS agency acquisition or contracting for equipment, services, or technology that directly benefits the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond desires to accept both the funds allocated by the Contra Costa County Health Services Hazardous Materials Division in the amount of \$688,386 and Agreement #23-551-4 in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond:

- The City of Richmond shall accept the allocation of \$229,462 annually from the Contra Costa County Health Services Emergency Medical Services Division.
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards program expenditures, under Fund 1007, Org 10706022 and Object Codes to be determined.
- The City Manager, or their designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund revenue account under Fund 1007, Org 10706022, Object 310051 for the deposit of the funds, which have been allocated to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
