

RESOLUTION NO. 145-22

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING AN OUTLINE AGREEMENT FOR
TECHNOLOGY-RELATED SERVICES FROM GOVERNMENT FINANCE
OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (GFOA) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000
PER YEAR FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 THROUGH 2023-2024**

WHEREAS in fiscal year 2000-2001, the Richmond City Council authorized establishing standing orders/outline agreements with certain technology-related vendors; and

WHEREAS the Richmond Municipal Code Section 2.52.330, Piggyback Procurement, allows the City to use piggyback solicitations that are in the best interest of the City of Richmond; and

WHEREAS the City of Richmond software systems are aging and in need of replacement that require a formal review and assessment; and

WHEREAS it is in the City's best interest to piggyback off the contract obtained by competitive bid process prepared and awarded by Butte County to utilize the software needs assessment services of GFOA; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Information Technology Division has demonstrated that purchasing can be expedited, paperwork can be reduced, better discounts realized, and service to the public can be improved through the development and implementation of standing orders/outline agreements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond, California, hereby authorizes the Division of Information Technology to use a standing order/outline agreement to purchase technology-related goods and services, with GFOA; and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond authorizes expenditures for standing orders/outline agreements to a level not to exceed \$50,000 per year with GFOA during the fiscal years 2022-2023 through 2023-2024.
