**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE
NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARKS ASSOCIATION COMMUNITY WELLNESS
HUB GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000 FOR
THE FOOD FIT FUN PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the National Recreation and Parks Association (“NRPA”) requested proposals on April 1, 2022, for the Community Wellness Hubs Grant funds to benefit low-income residents or communities of California; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond, as a municipal corporation and a charter city, applied and was awarded the Community Wellness Hubs Grant for the Food Fit Fun program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has received and accepted the Agenda Report regarding this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals accurate and have served together with the Agenda Report as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Richmond hereby agrees to use the Community Wellness Hubs grant funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by the NRPA and in accordance with Program Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute in the name of the City of Richmond, the Grant Agreement, and all other documents required by the NRPA for participation in the Community Wellness Hubs Grant Program, and any amendments thereto and accept and appropriate the grant funds.
