**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO
ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY,
ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$50,945 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY
\$50,945 IN THE 2022-2023 LIBRARY BUDGET**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2022-2023 City of Richmond operating budget, the Richmond Public Library was awarded \$50,945 from the California State Library; and

WHEREAS, the additional grant funding of \$50,945 will be able to provide adult literacy education and literacy activities to Literacy For Every Adult Program (LEAP) English as a Second Language (ESL) and adult basic education (ABE) participants

WHEREAS, this grant funding will continue ESL and ABE services at the Richmond Public Library's adult literacy service, LEAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2022-2023 Library Budget is adjusted to add \$50,945 to revenue and to add \$50,945 to expenditures.


